

Entering the AFA in Creative Writing to your UCAS application

1. To start entering your qualifications, use the 'Add qualification' button underneath each school or college you have added.

Add qualification

2. This will provide you with a cluster of qualification groups, and depending on which qualification you are entering you will need to find it under the relevant group. Clicking on a group will open a **shortlist of qualifications available and studied at your centre**.
3. Alternatively, if you select the '**All qualifications**' option, this will give you the shortlist for your centre. For Creative Writing, see further below.

Pick your qualification type

Choose the type of qualification you would like to add - you can search for specific qualifications shortlisted by your adviser within each group.

4. If your qualification is not here, use the search box. **You will need to do this for Creative Writing**. It is important that you choose the correct qualification type for each one you have.

5. If you are studying **AFA Creative Writing**, this needs to be added using the **search box**. Use the 'All qualifications' options and then start typing '**Other (UK Qualifications)**' in the search bar and select this.
6. You need to fill in the Subject/title of '**AFA Creative Writing**', the qualification date of **July 2025 (07/2025)** and the Awarding organisation – **WEB** – as shown. For

result type '**Pending**' in the same way you have selected for other qualifications you are doing.

7. Ensure you press '**Save qualifications**' when done.

Your teachers will then be able to add your predicted grade.

In addition, you should mention the AFA in your personal statement, and ask the person writing your testimonial to mention it as well, drawing on comments from your Creative Writing teacher.

Admissions Officers at UK universities will then be able to cross-reference your application against the information about the AFA published by UCAS.
